- **This cheese press is one of the many things on display.**

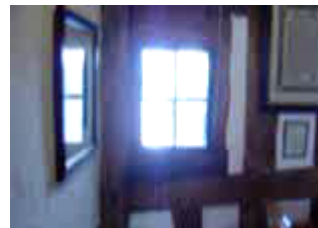


The Town room
